ACADEMY'S COVID-19 GUIDE

All important information regarding COVID-19 may be found on akbild.ac.at as well as in the [Academy's COVID-19 Guide](#). For further health related issues and psychological care see pages 38 to 41 or contact the International Office.

GENERAL RULES

The following measures must be observed at all times and in all buildings of the Academy, even when the stoplight system indicates a green light:

- Maintain a minimum distance of 1.5 m from other people who do not live in the same household
- Hand hygiene
- Cough hygiene
- Mouth and nose protection (at least where the minimum distance cannot be maintained)
- Regular airing
- Regular cleaning of workplace
- Abstaining from shaking hands and hugs (alternative forms of greeting required)
- Elevators to be used only alone or with persons of the same household
- In any form of acute respiratory infection – with at least one of the following symptoms for which there is no other plausible cause: coughing, sore throat, shortness of breath, catarrh of the upper respiratory tract, sudden loss of sense of taste/odor, with or without fever – please stay at home and **call the emergency number 1450.**



ACADEMY STOPLIGHT SYSTEM — GREEN & YELLOW

LEVEL I: LOW RISK / GREEN = PRESENCE MODE

Teaching, research and general operations take place at the Academy's locations, regardless of whether they are supplemented or enriched with digital elements and digital services. COVID-19-related requirements (such as distance rules, hygiene rules) apply.

- The general opening hours and the current house rules apply.

INTERNATIONAL OFFICE

- Personal consultation with protective masks.

LEVEL II: MODERATE RISK / YELLOW = DUAL MODE

Presence mode and parallel or simultaneous distance mode: Teaching and research as well as general operation are generally carried out at the university. Certain groups of people (e.g. risk groups, international students, etc.) who cannot be present on a regular basis due to COVID-19 prevention measures are offered distance mode.

- Operation in the usual manner, preferably in small groups. The general COVID-19 prevention measures, the laboratory and workshop regulations and the current house rules apply.
- In public areas of the buildings where situations of spontaneous encounters with other people may occur (such as corridors, kitchens, sanitary facilities, etc.), protective masks must be worn.

ATELIERS / STUDIOS

- Operation in the usual manner, preferably in small groups.

INTERNATIONAL OFFICE

- Personal consultation with protective masks.

ACADEMY STOPLIGHT SYSTEM — ORANGE

LEVEL III: HIGH RISK / ORANGE = HYBRID MODE

Parts of the Academy's operation are carried out on site and parts are offered or carried out digitally. This mode of operation goes beyond the presence and dual operation in that it is not only enriched with digital elements, but its digital elements form an essential part of the operation and physical presence is further restricted or the security and protection aspects are significantly intensified.

- Protective masks in public areas
- Access management is implemented: Please note the limitation of the number of persons present per room according to signage
- Admission of individuals not belonging to the Academy is to be limited to a minimum.

ATELIERS / STUDIOS

- Internal shift schedules for the institute ensure that direct contact between students and teachers is reduced to the necessary minimum.
- Commonly used surfaces and equipment (working materials, tools, protective visors, helmets, etc.) must be disinfected by the students themselves after each use.
- For mutual protection and in order not to damage the students' own equipment through constant damp cleaning, students are required to bring their own computer mice and keyboards for work on university computers and to use them exclusively.

ACADEMY STOPLIGHT SYSTEM – RED & COVID-19 PREVENTION

LEVEL IV: VERY HIGH RISK / RED = DISTANCE MODE

Teaching and research as well as general operations have been converted to digital operation as far as possible. Only the critical infrastructure as well as activities and services will be maintained, the discontinuation of which would lead to major risks and/or major financial damage for the Academy and its members.

- Workshops, laboratories, studios and ateliers are closed.

SYMPTOMS & IMPORTANT HOTLINES

SYMPTOMS

There occur infections without symptoms or with a mild course and symptoms of a common cold. Indications of a severe infection with SARS-CoV-2 include:

- Fever
- Cough
- Sore throat
- Shortness of breath
- Breathing difficulties
- Diarrhoea
- Sudden loss of taste and smell

In more severe cases, infections can cause pneumonia or severe breathing difficulties.

HANDLING OF SUSPECTED COVID-19-CASES


Do you think you have an infection / have been in contact with a confirmed case?

If a suspected COVID-19 case occurs among employees/students of the Academy:

- Stay at home!
- Contact the emergency number **1450** (Do NOT go to the hospital or a doctor without an appointment! – The public COVID-19 testing team will come to you.)
- Stay at home until you have a negative COVID-19 Test.
- In case of suspected COVID-19 problems, the International Office and the Vice Rector must be informed immediately. If the suspicion is confirmed, the International Office will inform the personal emergency contact of the incoming student as well as the Sending Institution and will take measures for the care of the incoming student in case of illness or quarantine.
- Send an email with full name and department or institute affiliation to: **vizerektorin_finanzen_personal@akbild.ac.at; s.baumgarten@akbild.ac.at; international@akbild.ac.at** The Vice Rector and the International Office are responsible for further internal communication.
- If **1450** arranges a test, the person concerned is immediately transferred to remote work or to distance learning.
- The tested person has to provide the **Vice Rector** with a list of all academy-internal **contact persons or attended courses of the past 48 hours**.
- In the event of a positive test result, the crisis management team will coordinate closely with the medical authorities.
- Don't worry! The team of the International Office will take care of you.

Do you have a negative result? — Contact the International Office.

- ☐ Make sure to deregister before you leave Vienna at the end of your stay!
- ☐ Nationals of EU/EEA countries and Switzerland who stay in Austria for longer than 3 months, have to apply at the competent municipal authority for a document called Anmeldebescheinigung (Confirmation of Registration; fee approx. 15,- EUR, responsible office: Arndtstraße 65-67, Stiege 1, 1st floor, 1120 Vienna) within the first 4 months of their stay.

Please note: Non-EU Students need visa for Austria.

STUDENT SEMESTER TICKET / SEMESTERKARTE

The student semester ticket is valid on all public transports in Vienna (Zone 100) and for the period of one term (winter term: September 1st - January 31st, summer term: February 1st - June 30th).

- **Students under 26** get student reduction on the ticket (online price: 150€).
- **Students (<26) with main residence in Vienna** (Meldezettel) get 50% discount off the regular student ticket (online price: 75€).

Documents required for purchasing the student ticket:

- ☐ confirmation of principal residence status (Hauptwohnsitz) in Vienna (Meldezettel)
- ☐ confirmation of enrollment (Inskriptionsbestätigung)
- ☐ registration number (Matrikelnummer)

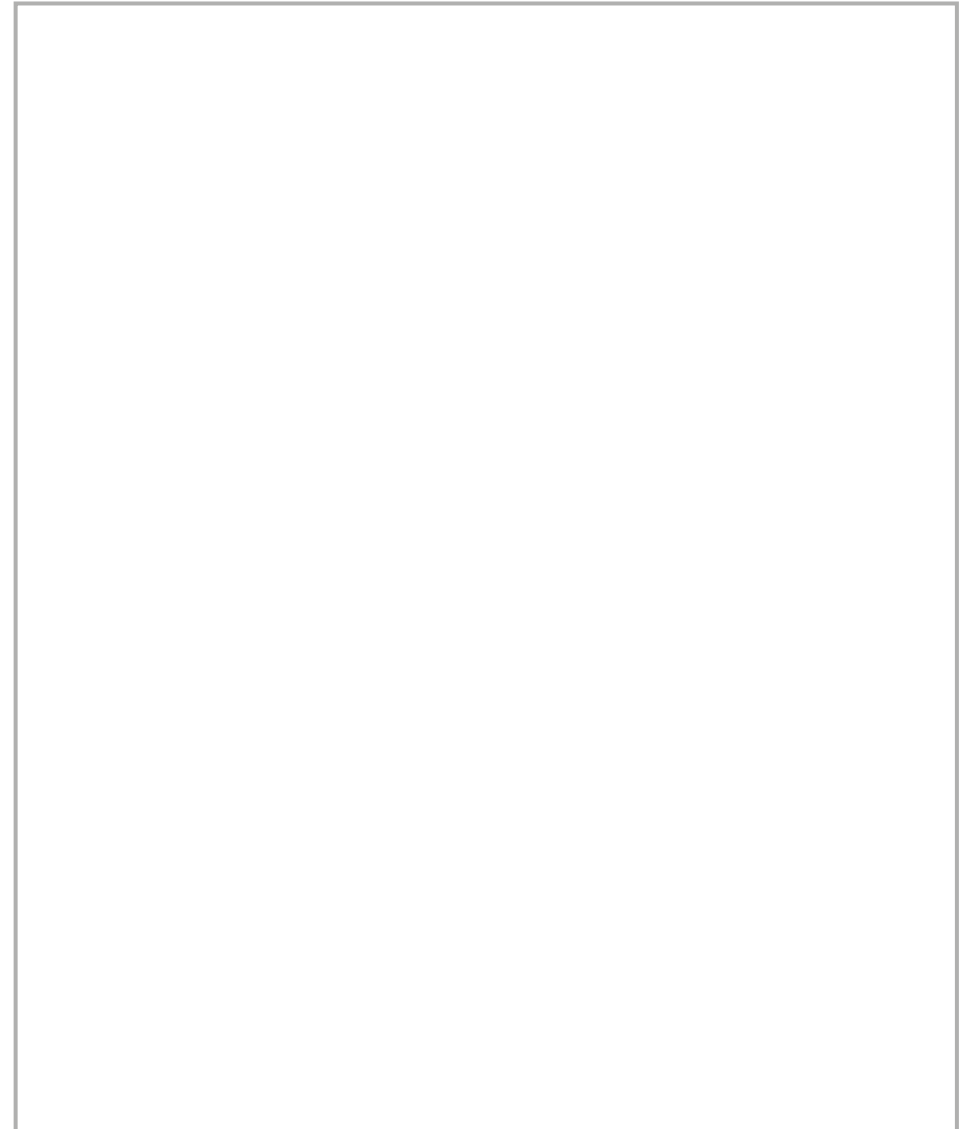

SAFETY/SECURITY & INSURANCE

Vienna is regarded as a safe city – nevertheless, we would like to share some thoughts about what you can do for your own safety:

- If you have the feeling something is wrong, if you don't feel at ease at a location or in a situation – act! Avoid the place or person and leave!
- Be aware of your surroundings. If you are wearing headphones make sure you still hear outside noises.
- Don't walk alone during night hours. Walk in groups whenever you can. Safety is in numbers, keep together.
- Stay in well lighted areas as much as possible.
- Use toilets in restaurants rather than at public places at night.
- Use ATM terminals located inside banks rather than independent terminals.
- Know the neighbourhood where you live and work. Check out the locations of police, hospitals, restaurants and stores that are open late.
- Let a friend or your flatmate know your destination and your estimated time of return. That way help can be arranged as quickly as possible.
- Be sure your belongings stay under your control at all times. Don't leave belongings unattended in studios/classrooms/pubs/train stations/public spaces/...
- Watch your drinks in bars and clubs and at all events.

Please note that you have to be able to identify yourself on request of the police.

Always carry your student ID with you as well as a personal ID / passport or at least a copy of it. More information may be found on: wien.gv.at/english/contact/emergency.html

HEALTH AND ACCIDENT INSURANCE

All students are obliged to have sufficient health and accident insurance that is valid in Austria. Make sure that your health and accident insurance is both sufficient and valid in Austria. EU citizens use their E-Cards.
