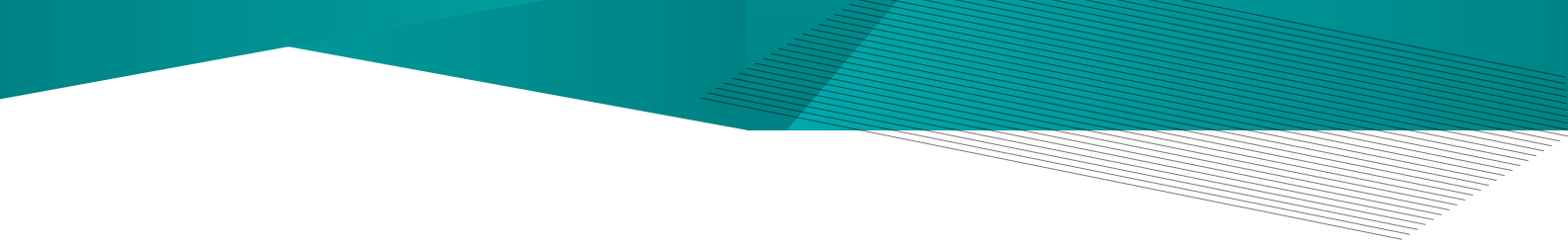

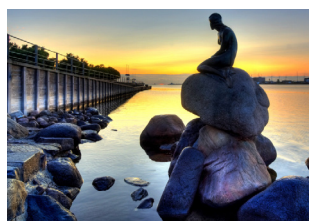
Denmark is a modern, safe, well-organised and culturally rich welfare state and is ranked among the countries in the world with the highest living standard.

The country is well-known for its flat topography and beautiful nature. The highest point only rises to 173 m above sea level. Denmark consists of 7,314 km coast-line which means that no one in Denmark lives more than 50 km from the sea.

Dannebrog, Denmark's flag, is strongly connected to the country and its people. It is seen all over and used during celebrations and festivities. It is the oldest flag in the world that is still being used by an independent country.

The Danes have been ranked the happiest people in the world several times. Maybe that can be explained by their free spirited, relaxed and tolerant attitude towards life. Common to all Danes is their tendency to take the ups and downs of life with a touch of irony, often self-irony.

- THE THIRD LARGEST CITY IN DENMARK



Odense is located in the heart of Denmark and is the third largest city with a population of approximately 190.000 people. As one of the oldest cities in Denmark, Odense has a long and exciting history. Its long history becomes apparent in the old part of the city as well as in all the historic buildings spread out in the city center. Odense is probably most famous for being the birth city of the world famous poet and fairytale writer Hans Christian Andersen. The city is known as the

- REGIONAL CAPITAL OF SOUTHERN DENMARK

Vejle is the ninth largest city in Denmark and the regional capital of Southern Denmark. The city has more than 50.000 inhabitants and Vejle County has more than 100.000

inhabitants. Vejle is best known for its nature and is beautifully located at the head of Vejle fjord. There are plenty of viewpoints where you can enjoy the fantastic scenery. For those who enjoy fishing, this is the place for catching sea trout, cod, and eel.
