How to apply for Bachelor's Degrees

Eligibility

Applicants who hold one of the following is eligible to apply for higher education studies:

- secondary education completed in Finland or
- a foreign degree/qualification, which gives eligibility for higher education in the awarding country
- further information at www.studyinfo.fi

It is NOT necessary to provide a language proficiency certificate. The English language skills will be tested at the entrance examinations.

How to apply?

Submit your application through the national joint application system at www.studyinfo.fi 10–25 January 2017 at 3.00 p.m. (UTC+2). Please, note that

- you can submit only one application and choose
 1–6 degree programmes in order of preference
- you may change your order of preference on the application form at any point during the application period
- check the needed attachments and deadlines on our website www.jamk.fi/en/Education/How-toapply/Bachelors-Degrees/

Entrance examinations

All eligible applicants will be invited to the entrance examinations. Exams will be held in April in Jyväskylä, Finland and JAMK also holds entrance examinations in several countries within Europe, Asia and America. Acceptance for Bachelor's Degrees

The results of student selection will be announced by 30 June 2017 at the latest. You will need to confirm your study place by 14 July 2017 at 3.00 p.m. (UTC+2). Studies will begin in the middle of August 2017, by which time you will need to be in Jyväskylä, Finland.

Cyber Security

The objective of this programme is to respond to the growing challenges of cyber security, with key programme elements including security needs in organisations, cyber security and its management, threat defence and influence on security.

Additionally, the programme deals with general security activities in the field of ICT, legislation in the field and national security criteria. Theoretical content also includes design, encryption and detection methods of information security. During the course students will learn how to detect known and unknown vulnerabilities in information technology devices and to test information security. Students will also learn how to defend against information security threats and to use proper counter-measures. The programme is delivered as multiform teaching, with contact hours taking place during weekends. Delivery is designed in such a way that it is possible to pass the examination whilst working full-time within two years.

Eligibility

The requirements for eligibility are a bachelor's degree in engineering in the field of information technology (ICT) or other equivalent degree, and at least three years of relevant work experience after the bachelor's degree.

How to apply for Master's Degrees

The application period is from 15 March to 5 April 2017, 3 p.m. (UTC+2) at www.studyinfo.fi

The minimum eligibility criteria for the Master's Degree Programmes are a suitable bachelor's degree (or other equivalent degree) and at least three years of relevant work experience gained after the bachelor's degree.

Attachments

Applicants applying with a qualification obtained outside of Finland must send copies of the certificates to the JAMK's Admission Services (degree and work certificates).

If the certificates are written in any language other than Finnish, Swedish or English, the applicant must enclose authorised translations of the certificates in one of the languages mentioned above. The translator must sign and stamp the translations. The copies

of degree certificates and work certificates must be submitted to our Admission Services immediately after filling the application form. Check the final deadline for providing the attachments: www.jamk.fi -> Education -> How to apply -> Masters Degrees.

All applicants who have demonstrated their eligibility will be invited to the entrance examination.

Are you interested in teaching? Teaching is a rewarding career choice for professionals from various fields.

Vocational Teacher Education provides the pedagogical qualification to allow you to teach your subject in Finland. This multiform post-degree programme is mainly intended for teachers and those wishing to become teachers at universities of applied sciences and institutions of vocational education.

JAMK's Teacher Education College offers you an enthusiastic and innovative learning environment. Our education is designed to meet the needs of adult students: the mode of study is flexible and each student is able to tailor his/her own studies. Studying part-time includes the basics of educational sciences and vocational pedagogy as well as teaching practice in other subjects.

Eligibility

In most cases eligibility to apply for the Vocational Teacher Education programme requires

- a relevant university or polytechnic degree and
- a minimum of three years' work experience in a field corresponding to the degree.

If your degree was completed outside of Finland, you will also need a decision on the recognition of your degree by the Finnish National Board of Education.


