STUDY IN THE CAPITAL OF NORTHERN DENMARK - AALBORG

With more than 200,000 inhabitants Aalborg, is one of the largest cities in Denmark. Since this is a university city, the number of students is approx. 40,000. As Aalborg is situated on the narrowest part of the picturesque Limfjord in the midst of wood-covered hills, moors and shallow marshes, nature is ever present. Aalborg is at the center of North Jutland, a region blessed by nature with many hours of sunshine.

If you wish to make excursions from the city, it is only a half-hour drive to the broad, white beaches of the North Sea or to lovely landscapes such as the Forest of Rold and the Jutlandic Ridge. Aalborg also prides itself of hosting the largest carnival in Northern Europe, the Tall Ships' Races, a ZOO, a museum of modern art and the famous bar and party street Jomfru Ane Gade, which is known across Denmark for its cheap drinks and great atmosphere.



PRACTICAL INFORMATION

Tuition fees:

All students are required to pay a tuition fee, except those coming from Nordic or EU countries or from Liechtenstein.

The tuition fee varies from € 8,000 – € 14,600 per year depending on the programme.

All students should bring a lap top and budget for €650 per month to cover living expenses in Aalborg.

Housing:

The municipality of Aalborg offers a housing guarantee (temporary) to all international students, and UCN helps everyone look for permanent housing.

Student job:

UCN offers a job service guide to assist international students who would like to find a part time job. Students can work 10-15 hours per week and earn a salary of € 13 per hour.

Other related activities:

Application deadline is 15 March for September intake and 5 December for February intake. Later applications are welcome but we CANNOT guarantee available places.
